4	WHEREAS, it is with great sorrow and sadness that members of the Louisiana
5	Senate have learned of the death of James Dawson Harrison, D.D.S.; and
6	WHEREAS, James died on April 7, 2015, at the age of ninety at his home in Pearl

8	WHEREAS, he was a seaman in the Navy during World War II and thereafter attend
9	dental school at the St. Louis School of Dentistry where, upon graduation, he served in the
10	United States Army Dental Corps; and
11	WHEREAS, James loved to garden, snow ski, and fish, but his passion was teaching
12	dental students; and
13	WHEREAS, he taught dental school at the St. Louis University School of Dentistry,
14	the Southern Illinois University as an Associate Dean of Education, and at the Louisiana
15	State University School of Dentistry; and
16	WHEREAS, after Hurricane Katrina, James returned part time to the Louisiana State
17	University School of Dentistry where he taught for seven additional years; and
18	WHEREAS, James received many honors throughout his professional career

including President of the American Association of Dental Schools, the American Academy
of Dental Electrosurgery, the American Academy of Crown and Bridges Prosthodontics, and
the national honorary dental fraternity, Omicron Kappa Upsilon; and
WHEREAS, he received the Golden Apple Award and the Dr. Allen A. Copping
Award for Excellence in teaching from his dental students and also received the Alumni
Merit Award from the St. Louis University Dental School; and
WHEREAS, James was a prolific writer and speaker and wrote more than forty-five
dental journal articles, co-edited two books, published one book, and spoke at numerous
dental conferences; and
WHEREAS, James is survived by his loving wife of fifty-seven years, Janice Mantle
Harrison, his son William and daughter-in-law Tina, his son Thomas and daughter-in-law
Ruchille, daughter Susan Harwood and son-in-law Chris, and his grandchildren Tyler
Harrison, James Harrison, Jacob Harrison, Carley Marquez, Andrew Marquez, Robert
McDaniel, Irene Adams, and Steven McDaniel, as well as many nieces and nephews; and
WHEREAS, he is preceded in death by his daughter Nancy Harrison Barron, his
brother, Earnest Harrison, and his sister-in-law Phyllis Harrison.
