A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Special Olympics Louisiana is a statewide organization that changes
lives by promoting understanding, acceptance, and inclusion between people with and
without intellectual disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Special Olympics Louisiana offers year-round programs for 14,200
children and adults with intellectual disabilities in all sixty-four parishes with the help of
15,000 volunteers; and

WHEREAS, Special Olympics Louisiana selected a delegation of sixteen athletes,
ten unified partners, and eight coaches from the Acadiana Area to attend the third Special
Olympics USA Games held on June 14-21, 2014, in New Jersey; and

Silver medals, nine Bronze medals, nine fourth place ribbons, two fifth place ribbons, one

coaches have exhibited great sportsmanship, talent, and respect and have represented
Louisiana with honor and pride.
