## 2 To encourage business owners and residents of Louisiana to take all measures to ensure the safety of their property, including considering the installation of security cameras to 3 4 enhance safety, deter crime, and otherwise provide for the protection of their 5 property. WHEREAS, security cameras were commonly once limited in use to provide security 6 7 for banks and by security intensive operations such as casinos and airports, but have now 8 become economical for small business owners and residents to purchase for an additional 9 layer of security at a business or at home; and 10 WHEREAS, according to the United States Bureau of Justice Statistics, 11 approximately seventy-five percent of all crime in the United States is property crime; and 12 WHEREAS, security cameras are known and utilized to reduce incidents such as 13 shoplifting, burglaries, and property vandalism; and 14 WHEREAS, in addition to deterring criminal activity, other beneficial reasons to purchase and install a security camera are to monitor the premises and property, and the 15 16 ability to observe activity at a business or home remotely; and WHEREAS, because of the benefits of security cameras and other security resources, 17 18 such as neighborhood watch organizations and monitored alarm systems, business owners
