<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the school board of a city, parish, or other local public system with one or more low-performing schools to enter into an agreement with the school board of a higher-performing public school system for the management and day-to-day operation of any or all of such schools, provided the higher-performing school system received a letter grade of "C" or higher for the previous two years.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the school board of each respective school system shall mutually develop the terms and scope of the management agreement, which shall be subject to the approval of a majority of the members of each school board.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

1. Requires a higher-performing public school system to have received a letter grade of "C" or higher for the two previous years in order to enter into a management agreement with a low-performing school.
