**Abstract:** Provides an exception to the crime of illegal carrying of weapons for the legislative auditor and designated investigative auditors when they are qualified in the use of firearms by P.O.S.T.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the crime of illegal carrying of weapons and provides exceptions to the crime for active justices or judges of the supreme court, courts of appeal, district courts, parish courts, juvenile courts, family courts, city courts, federal courts domiciled in the state of Louisiana, and traffic courts, members of either house of the legislature, officers of either house of the legislature, constables, coroners, designated coroner investigators, district attorneys and designated assistant district attorneys, U.S. attorneys and assistant U.S. attorneys and investigators, and justices of the peace when they are P.O.S.T. certified.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and expands this exception to include the legislative auditor and designated investigative auditors.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> Justice to the original bill:

1. Change "certified" to "qualified" regarding annual training in the use of firearms.
