- 7 On page 1, line 5, after "hereby" delete the remainder of the line and insert the following:
- 8 "amended and reenacted to read as follows:
 - §2531. Intentional littering prohibited; criminal penalties; simple littering prohibited; civil penalties; special court costs

I. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, this Section shall not apply 12 to any activity by persons owning or operating duly licensed commercial vehicles 13 14 engaged in the collection and transportation of solid waste, construction, or 15 demolition debris, or wood waste, as such terms are defined by the rules and regulations of the Department of Environmental Quality, occurring in the course of 16 17 servicing scheduled pickup routes pursuant to commercial or local government contracts or en route to. For the purposes of this Subsection, the term "collection" 18 shall mean the transfer of solid waste, construction or demolition debris, or wood 19 20 waste from a residential or commercial waste receptacle to the vehicle transporting 21 the waste or from such vehicle to an authorized pickup station, transfer station, or 22 disposal facility. To qualify for the The exemption provided for in this Subsection, 23 the commercial vehicle shall be covered at all times, except during loading and 24 unloading, in a manner that prevents rain from reaching the waste, prevents shall not 25 apply to waste from falling or blowing from the vehicle, and ensures that leachate from the waste is not discharged from the vehicle during transportation." 26
