ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RE INCREASE SG RV See Note Page 1 of 1

Authorizes the permitting and operation of microdistilleries in Louisiana

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes a microdistillery permit for holders of a Retailer's Class A for an annual fee of \$1,000 which authorizes the distilling, making, blending, rectifying or processing of any alcoholic beverage in the state. Quantity is limited to 12,000 gallons per year for retail consumption on or off the licensed premises. The permit holder is allowed to sell the beverage himself at retail but not through wholesale or other retail means. The beverage must be taxed in the same manner and rate as other alcoholic beverages.

The revenue would be generated at a rate of \$1,000 annually per permit holder, the permit fee authorized in the bill. It is uncertain how many microdistilleries will apply for the permit annually.
