

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
2 authorize and direct the Children's Code Committee of the Louisiana State Law Institute to
3 study the issue of restitution in delinquency cases, including the issue of parental restitution
4 in certain delinquency cases, and to report its findings to the Legislature of Louisiana,
5 including any recommendations for legislative changes as are appropriate.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the report be submitted to the Legislature of
7 Louisiana prior to the convening of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature of
8 Louisiana.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute work in
10 conjunction with and obtain input from all stakeholders deemed appropriate by the
11 Children's Code Committee.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
13 Louisiana State Law Institute.
