SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 99

JOINT RULES. Requires each organizational session include fiscal training for all legislators.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To adopt Joint Rule 21 of the Joint Rules of Order of the Senate and House of Representatives relative to legislators; to require fiscal training for all members of the House of Representatives and Senate.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of Louisiana that Joint Rule 21 of the Joint Rules of Order of the Senate and House of Representatives is hereby adopted to read as follows:

Joint Rule No. 21. Fiscal Training

A. Mandatory fiscal training for all members of the Senate and the House of Representatives shall take place during the organizational session held pursuant to Article III, Section 2(D) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

B. The training shall include an explanation of all sources of income for the budget, monies dedicated by the constitution, and other fiscal matters as may be deemed appropriate.
