2	hands, built a family home while working a full time job as a maintenance worker at
3	Evangeline Packing Company; and
4	WHEREAS, Mr. Broussard is a man of faith and was a dedicated parishioner of
5	St. Paul Apostle's Catholic Church in Lafayette, Louisiana, prior to moving back to New
6	Iberia, Louisiana; and
7	WHEREAS, Mr. Broussard is active in the church parish of St. Edward's Catholic
8	Church in New Iberia, Louisiana; and
9	WHEREAS, he lives a life of service to others, many times serving as the
10	maintenance person for the church, the Rectory, and the school; and
11	WHEREAS, Mr. Broussard is very active with the Knights of Peter Claver, a
12	member of St. Paul Council, Number Eleven, for over fifty years, the St. Vincent de Paul
