

**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2015 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 29 by Senator Cortez

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 4, line 8, after "service." insert "**If two or more employees share identical**  
 3 **promotional seniority in a class, then those employees shall be demoted in order of**  
 4 **their departmental seniority with the demotion of the employee with the least**  
 5 **departmental seniority being demoted first amongst those with identical promotional**  
 6 **seniority.**"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2

8 On page 5, at the end of line 25, after "class." insert "**If two or more employees share**  
 9 **identical promotional seniority in a class, then those employees shall be listed in order**  
 10 **of their departmental seniority, from highest to lowest, amongst those with identical**  
 11 **promotional seniority.**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 3

13 On page 6, at the end of line 7, after "established." insert "**If two or more employees share**  
 14 **identical promotional seniority in a class, then those employees shall be listed in order**  
 15 **of their departmental seniority, from highest to lowest, amongst those with identical**  
 16 **promotional seniority.**"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 4

18 On page 8, between lines 10 and 11, insert:

19 **"(d) If two or more employees share identical promotional**  
 20 **seniority in a class, then those employees shall be reinstated, or selected**  
 21 **and appointed for promotion, in order of their departmental seniority**  
 22 **with the reinstatement or promotion being offered to the employee with**  
 23 **the greatest departmental seniority amongst those with identical**  
 24 **promotional seniority.**"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 5

26 On page 8, at the end of line 28, after "lowest." insert "**If two or more employees share**  
 27 **identical promotional seniority in a class, then priority to positions amongst those**  
 28 **employees shall be in order of their total departmental seniority in the order of highest**  
 29 **to lowest amongst those with identical promotional seniority.**"
