10 "§2541.4. Deputy police chief; city of St. Martinville; unclassified service

A.(1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the position of deputy chief of police for the city of St. Martinville is in the unclassified service, and the right of selection, appointment, supervision, and discharge for such position is vested in the St. Martinville chief of police.

(2) The deputy chief of police shall have not less than five years of fultime law enforcement experience and shall have successfully completed a certified training program approved by the Peace Officer Standards and Training Council. Any person appointed to the position of deputy chief of police shall meet all qualifications and requirements as provided in the municipal compensation plan in effect at the time of his appointment.

B. Any person who resigns from a position in the classified service to accept an appointment as deputy chief of police shall not forfeit his seniority accumulated to the date of his resignation, but he shall not accumulate seniority during the time he is not in the classified service. If any such person resigns from the position of deputy chief of police or is terminated for any reason other than malfeasance in office, he shall be eligible to be reemployed to the same position in the classified service in which he was employed immediately preceding his resignation from the classified service. If the position has been filled or no longer exists, then his employer shall employ him in a comparable position."
