

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**HB 800****2015 Regular Session****Fannin**

APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Provides for supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2014-2015

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provide for net increases (decreases) in appropriations as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$7,276,572; Interagency Transfers by (\$5,284,557); Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$41,537,686; Statutory Dedications by \$1,401,107; and Federal Funds by \$55,806,989.
2. Deem certain prior appropriations bona fide obligations of the state through December 31, 2015 and June 30, 2016.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Appropriates supplemental funding, and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for FY 2014-2015. Provides for net increases (decreases) in appropriations as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$88,703,999; Interagency Transfers by \$1,179,304; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$30,688,793; Statutory Dedications by (\$14,724,243); and Federal Funds by (\$34,316,164).

Additionally appropriates \$124,958,094 out of the State General Fund from the FY 2013-14 surplus for debt defeasance and appropriates \$8,925,579 out of the State General Fund from the FY 2013-14 surplus towards the unfunded accrued liability of retirement systems.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
