<u>New law</u> authorizes the award of court costs and reasonable attorney fees for an action for injury caused to a person or person's property through acts of terror or terrorism.

<u>New law</u> specifies that the rights and remedies provided by <u>new law</u> are in addition to any other rights and remedies.

New law provides for the definition of "act of terror" or "terrorism" and "terrorist".

<u>New law</u> provides for payment of costs and reasonable attorney fees by the plaintiff upon determination by the court that the action is frivolous or fraudulent.

<u>New law</u> provides that an action brought under the provisions of <u>new law</u> shall be subject to a liberative prescriptive period of two years.
