(NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE LOCAL BILL – HLS 16RS-360)

Public notice is hereby given, as provided by Section 13, Article III of the Constitution of Louisiana, that there will be introduced at the forthcoming session of the Legislature of Louisiana, to be convened on March 14, 2016, a bill relative to the Wedgewood Crime Prevention and Improvement District in East Baton Rouge Parish; to modify the boundaries of the district; to provide relative to the imposition and collection of the district's parcel fee; to authorize the district, subject to voter approval, to impose a parcel fee of ninety-five dollars per parcel per year on residential properties and two hundred fifty dollars per parcel per year on commercial properties; to authorize the district to increase the parcel fee two times, without election, up to a maximum of one hundred fifty dollars per parcel per year on residential properties and four hundred dollars per parcel per year on commercial properties; to provide relative to the district's budget; and to provide for related matters.
