**Abstract:** Requires high schools to keep automated external defibrillators on their premises.

<u>Present law</u> provides that each high school that participates in interscholastic athletics shall have an automated external defibrillator on its premises, if funding is available.

<u>Proposed law</u> revises <u>present law</u> to delete references to interscholastic athletics and funding availability, and thereby provide that each high school shall have an automated external defibrillator on its premises.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides a legislative declaration indicating that the safety of young persons and the timely, effective provision of emergency medical services are public health priorities of this state.

Proposed law provides that it shall be known as the "Teddy Daigle and Shane Ozene Act".
