Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Changed date of report <u>from</u> an initial report by March 1, 2016, and a report of all findings by March 14, 2016, to an initial report on or before March 17, 2016.
- 2. Specified that state agencies are required to provide information which requires a uniform method to evaluate the contracts.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Directs the commissioner of administration, the commissioner of higher education, the lieutenant governor, the secretary of state, the attorney general, the treasurer, the commissioner of agriculture, the public service commission, and the commissioner of insurance to review all state contracts and identify any contracts currently in effect that can be terminated according to the terms of the contract, determine the amount of savings as a result of terminating the contract, take such action as is necessary to initiate the termination, excluding contracts for critical healthcare services and contracts for classroom activities related to elementary and secondary education. Requires an initial report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget on or before March 17, 2016.
