AN ACT 1 2 To enact R.S. 13:51, relative to certain judicial salaries; to provide for salary increases for judges of the courts of appeal as recommended by the Judicial Compensation 3 4 Commission; and to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 13:51 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §51. Salary as recommended by the Judicial Compensation Commission 8 Pursuant to the Judicial Compensation Commission's report dated 9 January 4, 2016, effective July 1, 2016, the actual salary of the judges of the courts of appeal shall be increased by one and one-half percent. Such increase 10 11 shall be in addition to the increase granted under R.S. 13:50(1). Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall only become effective in the 12 13 event that any salary increases conform to the appropriation provided in House Bill No. of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature. 14 Section 3. The provisions of Sections 1 and 2 shall become effective upon signature 15 by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to 16 17 become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the

1 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the

legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases, effective July 1, 2016, the salary of courts of appeal judges by one and one-half percent, as recommended by the Judicial Compensation Commission, if such increase conforms to the appropriation provided in House Bill No. _____ of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature. Further provides that such increase shall be in addition to the increase set forth in R.S. 13:50(1).
