COURTS/DISTRICT: Authorizes certain district courts to establish reentry courts

## AN ACT

To enact R.S. 13:5401(C)(10) and (11), relative to reentry courts; to authorize the creation of a reentry division of the Fourteenth and Thirty-Second Judicial District Courts; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 13:5401(C)(10) and (11) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
§5401. District courts; reentry courts; subject matter
C. The following district courts may assign certain divisions of the court as a reentry division of court in accordance with the provisions of this Section:
(10) The Fourteenth Judicial District Court.
(11) The Thirty-Second Judicial District Court.
