CRIME/PUNISHMENT. Adds surveillance by unmanned aircraft to the crime of criminal trespass. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 14:63(B) and (C), relative to criminal trespass; to provide that
3 surveillance by unmanned aircraft constitutes criminal trespass under certain
4 circumstances; to provide definitions; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 14:63(B) and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7 follows:

8 §63. Criminal trespass

9 * * *

10 B.(1) No person shall enter upon immovable property owned by another
11 without express, legal, or implied authorization.

12 **(2) For purposes of this Subsection:**

13 **(a) The phrase "enter on immovable property" as used in this**
14 **Subsection, in addition to its common meaning, signification, and connotation,**
15 **shall include the operation of an unmanned aircraft system in the air space over**
16 **immovable property owned by another with the intent to conduct surveillance**
17 **of the property or of any individual lawfully on the property.**
