Walsworth

<u>Present law</u> allows the commissioner of conservation to charge certain fees to the industries under the jurisdiction of the office of conservation.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a transfer stations regulatory fee for exploration and production waste fee of \$2,500.

Proposed law reduces the fee from \$2,500 to \$1,000.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a commercial facility reuse material applications fee of \$300.

Proposed law reduces the fee from \$300 to \$100.

<u>Present law</u> provides for an authorization for after-hours disposal of exploration and production waste fee of \$150.

Proposed law repeals present law.

SB 229 Original

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
