5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:3991(6) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§3991. Charter schools; requirements; limitations; renewal; amendment; revocation

9	E. * * *
10	(6) Require the parent or legal guardian of any student to disclose
11	medical information or special education needs prior to the student being
12	enrolled in the charter school, unless otherwise specifically required by law.
13	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
14	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
15	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
16	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
17	effective on the day following such approval.
