4 WHEREAS, born and raised in Shreveport, Louisiana, Sharon L. Dunn obtained her  
5 first undergraduate degree from Northeast Louisiana University in pre-physical therapy, a  
6 Bachelor of Science in Physical Therapy from LSU Health Sciences Center in Shreveport  
7 (LSUHSC) in 1987, a Masters in Health Sciences in 1996, and then earned a PhD in Cellular  
8 Biology and Anatomy in 2006; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Dunn obtained certification from the American Board of Physical  
10 Therapy Specialties in Orthopaedic Physical Therapy in 1996, was recertified in 2006 and  
11 utilizes this content expertise in her teaching, research and clinical practice; and

12 WHEREAS, since 1990, Dr. Dunn has been on the faculty at LSUHSC and currently  
13 serves as associate professor and director of the doctorate of physical therapy program and  
14 chair of the rehabilitation sciences department; and

16 Orthopaedic Physical Therapy at LSUHSC in 2008, which has since produced nineteen
