Abstract: Provides for the divisions and officers of the Dept. of Children and Family Services (DCFS).

<u>Present law</u> divides DCFS into the division of programs and the division of operations and provides for a deputy secretary for each division.

<u>Proposed law</u> renames the division of programs <u>to</u> the division of child welfare and renames the division of operations <u>to</u> the division of family support. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for an assistant secretary for each division to be appointed by the governor.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the secretary of DCFS to appoint a single deputy secretary to perform duties and functions determined and assigned by the secretary. <u>Proposed law</u> requires the deputy secretary to serve as acting secretary in the absence of the secretary.

<u>Proposed law</u> updates references to the division of operations and division of programs in <u>present</u> law to either the division of child welfare or the division of family support.

Effective July 1, 2016.
