Abstract: Provides for requirements for training early learning center employees on recognizing and preventing shaken baby syndrome.

<u>Present law</u> requires the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to promulgate regulations for early learning center licensing. Provides that such regulations accomplish certain actions as specified in <u>present law</u> including promoting the health, safety, and welfare and ensuring adequate supervision of children attending early learning centers. <u>Proposed law</u> adds a requirement that such regulations include requirements for employees to receive training in recognition and prevention of shaken baby syndrome.
