**Abstract:** Authorizes the 4<sup>th</sup> JDC to develop a reentry division of court.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the 1<sup>st</sup> JDC, 11<sup>th</sup> JDC, 15<sup>th</sup> JDC, 19<sup>th</sup> JDC, 22<sup>nd</sup> JDC, 24<sup>th</sup> JDC, 25<sup>th</sup> JDC, and the Criminal District Court for the parish of Orleans to create a reentry division which would be responsible for developing a workforce development sentencing program with specific qualifications and requirements.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and authorizes the 4th JDC to also establish a reentry division of court.
