- 6 (a) Have at least eight years of progressively responsible experience in law enforcement positions, at least two years of which must have been in positions that included administrative or supervisory responsibilities.
- 9 (b) Have law enforcement experience in patrol operations, criminal investigations, public training, and related areas of police department operations and management.
- 12 (c) Pass a medical examination designed to demonstrate good mental and physical health sufficient to perform any required duties of the position.
- 14 (d) Be a resident of Washington Parish or willing to become a resident of
  15 Washington Parish within ninety days of employment."
