Abstract: Requires the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education to authorize an online or virtual education provider for the Course Choice Program if it meets specified criteria.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Course Choice Program, through which students may enroll in courses offered by a course provider, including online or virtual education providers. Requires that course providers be authorized by the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) and provides a process for such authorization.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that notwithstanding such authorization process, BESE shall authorize an online or virtual education provider if its curriculum meets all of the following criteria:

- (1) It is used by least 10 school systems.
- (2) It is aligned with the standards of the International Assoc. for K-12 Online Learning.
- (3) It is cleared by the National Collegiate Athletic Assoc.
