Abstract: Requires voter approval prior to a parish or municipality imposing a civil fine for a traffic violation based on evidence captured by an automated traffic enforcement system.

Proposed law prohibits a local parish authority or local municipal authority from imposing a civil fine for a violation of any traffic law, ordinance, rule, or regulation based on evidence captured by an automated traffic enforcement system, unless the imposition of civil fines has been authorized by the voters.

Proposed law authorizes any local parish authority or local municipal authority that has imposed such civil fines prior to July 1, 2017 to continue to do so until July 1, 2017, without an election.
