<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Governor's Office of Disability Affairs to create a service dog registry and issue an identification card for the owner and a patch for a service dog indicating that the service dog has been properly trained.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that an individual seeking to register his service dog shall provide the following:

- (1) An affidavit signed by the applicant attesting that the dog has been properly trained as a service dog by a trainer duly licensed by the Louisiana Department of Veterans Affairs.
- (2) Documentation from an appropriate health care or rehabilitation professional certifying that the applicant requires the assistance of a service dog due to a military service-related disability.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Louisiana Department of Veterans Affairs to establish the qualifications for, and issue a license to, a dog trainer who wishes to train service dogs eligible for inclusion in the Louisiana Service Dog Registry.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that veterans and members of the armed forces seeking training as a service dog trainer shall be eligible for any available education-related programs or benefits.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Governor's Office of Disability Affairs and the Louisiana Department of Veteran's Affairs shall promulgate rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to implement proposed law.
