**Abstract:** Provides that the additional penalty provisions applicable to a person in possession of a firearm and a controlled dangerous substance do not apply to possession of marijuana of 14 grams or less.

Present law provides penalties for illegal carrying of weapons.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides additional penalties for the use, possession, or control of a firearm while committing a crime of violence, during the sale or distribution of a controlled dangerous substance (CDS), or while in the possession of a CDS.

<u>Present law</u> provides penalties of a fine of not more than \$10,000 and imprisonment of not less than five nor more than 10 years without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes these additional penalties for possession of 14 grams or less of marijuana and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> Justice to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Exempts the possession of marijuana of 14 grams or less from additional penalties of possession of a firearm while possessing a controlled dangerous substance.
