CONSERVATION OR -\$85,000 SD RV See Note Provides for certain fees collected by the office of conservation. (gov sig)

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<u>Present law</u> authorizes the commissioner of conservation to charge a transfer stations regulatory fee for exploration and production waste of \$2,500. <u>Proposed law</u> reduces the fee to \$1,000. <u>Present law</u> provides for a commercial facility reuse material applications fee of \$300. <u>Proposed law</u> reduces the fee to \$100. <u>Present law</u> provides for an authorization for afterhours disposal of exploration and production waste fee of \$150. Proposed law repeals the fee.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

<u>Proposed law</u> reduces fees associated with existing expenditures of the Department of Natural Resources. To the extent these activities cannot be offset by other revenue sources, there may be an expenditure impact for the department. DNR reports that the impacted fees support 2 TO positions, whose loss may slow agency response times for processing applications, approving permits, and reviewing and assessing reports.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

DNR projects a reduction of approximately \$85,000 per year in the Statutory Dedications-Oil and Gas Regulatory Fund due to the fee reductions in proposed law. Proposed law includes a \$1,500 reduction in the transfer stations regulatory fee for exploration and production waste, a \$200 reduction in the commercial facility reuse material applications fee, and the elimination of the after-hours disposal of exploration and production waste fee. Projected revenues from these fees is expected to be \$105,500 in FY 17; under proposed law, revenues would decrease to \$20,000.
