A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recognize Tuesday, April 19, 2016, as the fourth annual Resource Environmental Solutions Louisiana Tree Day at the state capitol.

WHEREAS, April 22, 2016, is known worldwide as Earth Day, and this date is appropriate to acknowledge the generous donation of native tree species made to the state of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, Resource Environmental Solutions, Louisiana's leading provider of wetland ecosystem and habitat restoration, has restored, enhanced, and preserved over thirty-two thousand acres of wetlands in Louisiana, and has donated native Louisiana cypress and live oak trees to parishes across the state; and

WHEREAS, this donation is a gift that enhances, beautifies, restores, and enriches the quality of life for the citizens of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, Resource Environmental Solutions has planted, grown, propagated, and potted over seven million native cypress and live oak trees at its nursery in Pointe Aux Chenes and has launched a repeatable environmental initiative that helps rebuild and strengthen Louisiana's ravaged natural ecosystems.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Tuesday, April 19, 2016, as Resource Environmental Solutions Louisiana Tree Day at the state capitol and does hereby express appreciation for the ongoing efforts and generous donation of native-grown live oak and cypress trees to parishes throughout Louisiana.
