Abstract: Provides that a document transferring ownership of a vehicle which is declared a total loss to an insurance company may be endorsed by signature of the owner without requiring notarization of the signature.

<u>Present law</u> provides that no person shall transfer ownership of a motor vehicle, to any purchaser, without delivery of a certificate of title that has been executed in the presence of a notary public or two witnesses.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that a document transferring ownership of a total loss motor vehicle to an insurance company by the owner's signature is a valid endorsement.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Insurance</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Add to the methods of transferring title to an automobile by endorsement that the signature of the owner of a motor vehicle declared a total loss by an insurance company is sufficient to transfer title of the motor vehicle to the insurance company without being notarized.
- 2. Make technical changes.
