AN ACT

To authorize the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to rename the
correctional facility located at Cottonport, Louisiana, as the Raymond Laborde
Correctional Center; and to provide for related matters.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 42:267 or any other provision of
law to the contrary, the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections may
designate and rename the correctional facility at Cottonport, Louisiana, as the "Raymond
Laborde Correctional Center" in honor of former state representative Raymond Laborde.
Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.
