UTILITIES: Provides relative to the administration and regulation of underground utilities and facilities

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Restricts a nonexclusive list, which enumerates certain activities included in the definition of "excavation" or "excavate", by removing the phrase "or any other activity".

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> defines "excavation" or "excavate". <u>Proposed law</u> amends the definition of "excavation" or "excavate". <u>Proposed law</u> removes an element of intent by deleting the phrase "for the purpose of" from the definition. Further, <u>proposed law</u> makes an illustrative list of examples nonexclusive and provides for additional circumstances to be included in the definition of "excavation" or "excavate". <u>Proposed law</u> provides an exception to exclude certain circumstances resulting as a consequence of any force majeure, act of God, or act of nature.

<u>Present law</u> enumerates certain holidays to be observed by regional notification centers as defined in <u>present law</u>. <u>Proposed law</u> adds Memorial Day and Christmas Eve to the list of holidays to be observed by regional notification centers.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
