CONDOMINIUMS: Provides with respect to condominium associations

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Clarifies language to reflect that if a lien is filed and dues are not owed, then the condominium association shall be liable for attorney's fees and costs.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides that a recorded privilege against a condominium parcel preserves the right to file suit for one year from the date of recordation.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends the privilege to file suit against a condominium parcel <u>from</u> one year <u>to</u> five years from the date of recordation.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the condominium association to pay attorney fees and all associated costs if the condominium association files a lien for dues not owed which requires an owner or interest holder to file suit to have the lien or privilege released.
