Any defendant, other than an indigent, who pleads guilty or is convicted of an offense by the Municipal and Traffic Court of the city of 6 7 New Orleans shall be assessed costs not to exceed the sum of fifteen dollars 8 for each offense, such costs to be in addition to any fine, clerk's fees or costs 9 or any other fee or costs provided by law or sentence imposed by the court. 10 When any defendant, other than an indigent, fails to pay the added costs referred to in this Subsection, he shall be sentenced to a term of thirty days 11 12 in the House of Detention. *" 13
