**Abstract:** Prohibits clerks of district courts from refusing to record instruments for noncompliance with recordation requirements and deletes the \$10 noncompliance fee.

<u>Present law</u> provides that every document filed for recordation shall be captioned with the type of the act, a two-inch margin on the top, and a one-inch margin at the bottom and sides on the first page, with no less than an 8-point font.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any document in noncompliance with <u>present law</u> shall be charged a \$10 noncompliance fee per document.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes the <u>present law</u> noncompliance fee and prohibits clerks of district court from refusing to record an instrument for noncompliance with the provisions of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that documents in noncompliance with <u>present law</u> shall not invalidate the instrument or the effect given to its recordation.

Effective October 1, 2016.
