1. Restores present provisions that a private entity not be considered a public or quasi-public entity or public body as a result of contracting with the District.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Algiers Development District in Orleans Parish provides for the composition and powers, including the authority to levy ad valorem taxes. Authorizes the district to execute contracts with private entities for the purpose of development within the district. Provides that no private entity is to be considered a public or quasi-public entity or a public body as a result of executing a contract with the district or as the result of receiving or expending funds on behalf of the district.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains these provisions and provides that these contracts by the district be subject to audit and review by the legislative auditor as provided by law.

<u>Proposed law</u> is not to be construed to apply to any contract executed by the district with an investor owned utility regulated by the Louisiana. Public Service Commission or the governing authority of the city of New Orleans.
