28	(18)(a) To require a reasonable amount of bond with security from an
29	operator to plug each well and site cleanup required by Paragraph 1 of this
30	Subsection. Except as otherwise provided in this Subparagraph, the amounts
31	shall be established by the commissioner and may be on an individual-well or
32	multiple-well basis and may be categorized based on the well's location. The
33	establishment and the required funds of a site-specific trust account shall be
34	governed by R.S. 30:88.
35	(b)(i) For an individual well located on land of a depth equal to or less
36	than three thousand feet, the amount required shall be no more than two dollars
37	per foot.

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1 (ii) For multiple wells located on land, the amount required shall be no 2 more than twenty-five thousand dollars for ten or fewer wells, one hundred 3 twenty-five thousand dollars for eleven to ninety-nine wells, or two hundred 4 fifty thousand dollars for one hundred or more wells. 5 (c) Operators shall not be required to provide bond with security in the 6 following circumstances: 7 (i) All wells exempt from financial security prior to September 1, 2015, 8 shall remain exempt so long as they remain with their current operator or the 9 operator's immediate family as defined in R.S. 42:1102(13). A change of name 10 by an operator of record through acquisition, merger, or otherwise does not 11 preclude the successor operator from maintaining the exemption described 12 herein. 13 (ii) Any well declared to be orphan by the commissioner or any well held 14 by another operator and subsequently transferred to an operator with no 15 outstanding violations and a record of compliance with applicable statutory 16 requirements and the rules and regulations of the office of conservation for a 17 period of forty-eight months immediately prior to the transfer. 18 (iii) Any well for which the operator has either earned or has received 19 a plugging credit for plugging an orphaned oilfield site in accordance with rules 20 and regulations promulgated by the commissioner. Such rules and regulations 21 shall, at a minimum, provide for criteria under which plugging credits may be 22 earned, requirements and procedures for issuance, transfer, and acceptance of 23 such credits, and require approval by the commissioner for the earning, using, 24 banking, or selling of the plugging credits. The criteria for earning a plugging 25 credit shall include, but not limited to, that the orphaned oilfield site plugged

for which a credit is earned shall be inactive for at least five years prior to being
