CHILDREN/SUPPORT. Provides for the schedule of basic child support obligations

DIGEST

Present law provides a child support guideline schedule which is based on economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

Proposed law amends present law to incorporate the most recent economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

Present law provides monthly basic child support obligations for combined adjusted monthly gross incomes beginning with \$0 per month.

Proposed law amends the monthly basic child support obligations and utilizes \$0 - \$900 as the minimum adjusted monthly gross income.

Present law provides a ceiling of \$30,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

Proposed law amends present law by raising the ceiling from \$30,000 to \$40,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Changes the minimum amount utilized for monthly basic child support obligations from \$950 to \$0-\$950.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to the reengrossed bill

1. Changed certain provisions of the schedule to reflect accurate economic estimates.
