Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 291 by Senator Mills

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

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On page 1, after line 9, delete the remainder of the page and on page 2, delete lines 1 through

8 "B.(1) Without prescription or referral, a physical therapist may 9 perform an initial evaluation or consultation of a screening nature to 10 determine the need for physical therapy and may perform physical therapy 11 or other services provided in Subsection C of this Section. However, 12 implementation of physical therapy treatment shall otherwise be based on the prescription or referral of a person licensed to practice medicine, surgery, 13 14 dentistry, podiatry, or chiropractic. 15 16

(2) For the treatment of a specific condition, other than under the circumstances provided for in Subsection C of this Section, a physical therapist may implement physical therapy treatment for a diagnosis rendered by a healthcare provider within the previous year or a diagnosis of a permanent physical disability with or without a prescription or referral of a person licensed to practice medicine, surgery, dentistry, podiatry, or chiropractic if the physical therapist meets one of the following criteria:

- (a) The physical therapist has a doctorate in physical therapy and two years of clinical practice experience.
 - (b) The physical therapist has a doctorate in physical therapy and a post-graduate certification.
 - (c) The physical therapist has a doctorate in physical therapy and an American Board of Physical Therapy specialties board certification.
 - (d) The physical therapist has a doctorate in physical therapy and residency or fellowship training.
- 37 (e) The physical therapist has five years of clinical practice

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40(3) No physical therapist shall render a medical diagnosis of an41acute or chronic condition."
