2 3 4	On page 1, line 10, after " <u>user</u> " and before " <u>directly</u> "delete " <u>when caused proximately or caused</u> " and insert " <u>provided the public road user used reasonable care in the use of the road, and his injury or death is caused</u> "
5	AMENDMENT NO. 2
6	On page 2, delete lines 23 through 25 and insert the following:
7 8	"(2) If a person is found to have committed an offense under this Section that caused a death, the court may impose any or all of the following:
9 10	(a) Imprisonment with or without hard labor for not more than two years.
11	(b) A fine of not more than five thousand dollars.
12 13	(c) Completion of a court-approved motor vehicle accident prevention program.
14 15	(d) Performance of not more than five hundred hours of community service.
16 17	(e) Suspension of driving privileges for a period of not more than one year."
18 19	E. For purposes of this Section, "careless manner" shall mean the failure to drive in a careful and prudent manner."
