- "F.(1) The attorney general may decline to provide representation to a deputy
  constable who is not in compliance with the provisions of R.S. 13:2583.1 through
  2583.7 including but not limited to the failure to file a copy of the oath of office with
  the office of the attorney general or failure to attend requisite training.
  - (2) If a determination is made by a court that a deputy constable was not acting in the discharge of his duties and within the scope of his office at the time of the alleged act or omission, or that he was acting in an intentionally wrongful manner or was grossly negligent, a deputy constable may be required to reimburse the office of the attorney general for expenses incurred including court costs and reasonable attorney fees.
- 22 G. The provisions of this Section that are applicable to deputy constables 23 shall only apply to deputy constables serving on or before August 1, 2016."
