10 11	(2)(a) Passage of a national examination approved by the board pursuant to R.S. 37:3557.
12 13 14	(b) All test results presented for an initial licensure shall be directly received by the board from the issuing agency such as the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards.
15 16	(3)(a) Citizenship or legal residency in the United States and the ability to read, write, speak, and understand English fluently.
17 18 19	(b) As proof of citizenship or legal residency, the applicant shall present in person an original government-issued form of picture identification, such as a driver's license, and a social security card.
20 21	(c) A verbal jurisprudence test shall be administered by the board or an assigned representative thereof.
22 23	(4) Within the five years preceding the date of the application, the applicant has not been convicted of a nonviolent felony.
24 25 26	(5) The applicant has never been convicted of or pled nolo contendere to a violent felony or a criminal offense involving sexual misconduct.
27	(6) The applicant has submitted to and cleared a background check.
28 29 30 31	C. D. After review of the evidence submitted, the board shall notify each applicant that his application and such evidence is accepted or rejected. If an application is rejected, such notice shall state the reasons for the rejection.
32 33 34 35 36	D: <u>E.</u> The board shall issue a license to each person who meets the qualifications provided for in this Section upon payment of the professional license fee provided pursuant to R.S. 37:3562. The license, in the form of a Licensed Massage Therapist Identification Card (LMT-ID Card), grants all professional rights, honors, and privileges to the licensed massage therapist.
37 38 39	E: <u>F</u> . Each license granted shall have a validity period of one calendar year and shall have an expiration date as determined by administrative rules promulgated by the board.
