AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE. Prohibits issuance of a ticket for violation of compulsory motor vehicle liability security provisions if security can be verified electronically at time ticket is issued. (8/1/16)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Clarifies the prohibition against issuance of a citation for failure to have a document evidencing compulsory security on the vehicle if it can be immediately verified electronically.

<u>Present law</u> requires the owner or operator of a motor vehicle on a state public highway to have within the vehicle a document evidencing that the vehicle is in compliance with law for compulsory motor vehicle liability security.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains these provisions but prohibits issuance of a citation resulting in a penalty, fine, or fee for failure to have proof of compulsory motor vehicle liability security contained in the motor vehicle if the law enforcement officer is able to electronically verify that the owner or operator has motor vehicle liability security currently covering the vehicle at the time of issuance of the citation.

Effective Aug. 1, 2016.
