  physical therapy services under any health care plan, insurance policy, or
  workers' compensation plan or circumvent any requirement for
  preauthorization of services in accordance with any health care plan,
  insurance policy, or workers' compensation plan.
- 24(2) Prior to providing any physical therapy service, physical25therapists shall provide each patient written notification that the service26may not be covered by insurance or workers' compensation. The27physical therapist shall obtain written acknowledgment from the patient28that the patient has been informed of the possibility of out-of-pocket29expenses.
