11"B.(1)(a) Except as provided in Subparagraphs (e) and (f) of this Paragraph,12Any any retired teacher who returns to active service covered by the provisions of13this Chapter within the twelve-month thirty-six-month period immediately following14the effective date of such retirement shall have his retirement benefits suspended for15the duration of such active service or the lapse of twelve thirty-six months from the16effective date of his retirement, whichever occurs first, even if such service is based17on employment by contract or corporate contract. "

20 On page 2, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

21 "(d) Except as provided in Subparagraphs (e) and (f) of this Paragraph, H if 22 the reemployment of a retired teacher is based on an agreement between the retired 23 teacher and his employer where such agreement was perfected prior to the retiree's effective date of retirement and where the agreement allows for the retiree to become 24 25 reemployed within twelve thirty-six months immediately following the effective date 26 of his retirement, the retiree shall not be eligible to receive retirement benefits for the twelve-month thirty-six-month period immediately following the effective date of 27 such reemployment, regardless of whether such agreement is express or implied. The 28 29 provisions of this Subparagraph shall be applied prospectively beginning on July 1, 30 2001. 31

(e) Any retired teacher who returns to active service covered by the
provisions of Paragraph (A)(4) of this Section within the twelve-month period
immediately following the effective date of such retirement shall have his retirement
benefits suspended for the duration of such active service or the lapse of twelve
months from the effective date of his retirement, whichever occurs first, even if such
service is based on employment by contract or corporate contract.

37 (f) Any person who has been retired for twelve months and who has returned
38 to active service pursuant to the provisions of this Section prior to May 15, 2016,
39 shall continue to be subject to the provisions of R.S. 11:710(B)(1)(a) and (d) in effect
40 on June 30, 2016.
