 Requires the Dept. of Education to collect and report certain special education data. (gov sig)

Present law requires the department of Education (DOE) to collect and report certain student data. Proposed law requires additional data collection and publication of reports on students with exceptionalities. The information collected and reported shall include breakouts of speech or language impairment category and breakouts of intellectual disability categories, not including gifted and talented, by city, parish, or other local school board. The data for each disability classification shall be reported in total as well as unduplicated counts by race, gender, age and sex. Further requires data collection to include information on student discipline for each public school, including suspensions and expulsions broken down by categories of ten days or less, restraint and seclusion procedures, and unilateral removals to an interim educational setting by disability classification and reason for removal. Effective upon governor's signature.
